
East Fishkill Area Hometown Heroes

Gold star will indicate that the hero was killed in battle. A blue star will indicate survival. Veterans or members of their family will asked to be interviewed by local high school students who will then give a report about the veteran. This will be on a voluntary basis only. Charles "Manny" Bacon was the first Hopewell Junction resident to die during World War II and his will be the first banner made.
